

# WoW The Burning Crusade

The thing is alot of the Horde Races like the new Blood Elves in the Burning Crusade aren't really bad just sort of fallen angles. It is worth baring in mind though that the Horde and Alliance cannot talk to each other, so if you have friends that play you might want to be on the same side that they are so that you can play together. Another thing worth thinking about is the server you'll be playing on. Wow will by default assign you to which ever has the most space. The server is basically the database which all your characters info and history is stored on, again if your friend is not on that server you simply wont be able to play with them. Characters can be changed from servers but it costs an additional fee and can take a few days.

If your new to Wow you get to pick your race, their are 8 races in on both sides of the factions.
